Narrative Lectionary 2016-2017

Readings for Year 3 (Luke)

The **preaching texts** are always listed first. During the fall, Old Testament texts are the primary vehicle for proclaiming the biblical story. The gospel readings become primary texts on the Fourth Sunday of Advent. A brief accompanying reading (selected from one of the gospels before Christmas and after Easter; selected from Psalms from Christmas through Easter) is noted in parentheses. *These accompanying readings are optional*.

September	11	Creation and Fall Seventeenth Sunday after	Genesis 2:4b-7, 15-17; 3:1-8 (Luke 11:4)
		Pentecost	Creation, Garden of Eden, fall into sin.
September	18	God's Promise to Abraham	Genesis 15:1-6 (Luke 3:8)
		Eighteenth Sunday after Pentecost	God promises Abraham descendants as numerous as the stars. Abraham believes.
September	25	God Works through Joseph Nineteenth Sunday after Pentecost	Genesis 37:3-8, 17b-22, 26-34; 50:15-21 (<i>Luke 6:35</i>) Joseph's dreams lead to family conflict and he is sold into slavery. Yet in the end Joseph forgives. God works for good.
October	2	The Promise of Passover	Exodus 12:1-13; 13:1-8 (Luke 22:14-20)
		Twentieth Sunday after Pentecost	Passover: the blood of the lamb and unleavened bread signify God's sacrifice of the lamb God's deliverance.
October	9	Golden Calf	Exodus 32:1-14 (Luke 23:34)
		Twenty-first Sunday after Pentecost	Golden calf shows unfaithfulness at Mt. Sinai. Moses intercedes, God forgives.
October	16	God Answers Hannah	1 Samuel 1:9-11, 19-20; 2:1-10 (Luke 1:46-55)
		Twenty-second Sunday after Pentecost	Samuel's birth is God's answer to Hannah, who sings of God's care for the needy.
October	23	God's Promise to David	2 Samuel 7:1-17 (Luke 1:30-33)
		Twenty-third Sunday after Pentecost	God's promise to David concerning his heir, who will be God's Son and whose kingdom will endure forever.

October	30	God's Care for the Widow	1 Kings 17:1-16 [17-24] (Luke 4:24-26)
		Twenty-fourth Sunday after Pentecost (or Reformation Sunday)	Elijah and the widow; God's care for those on the margin.
November	6	Jonah and God's Mercy	Jonah 1:1-17; 3:1-10 [4:1-11] (Luke 18:3)
		Twenty-fifth Sunday after Pentecost (or All Saints Sunday)	Jonah's attempted escape from God, God's mercy on the people of Nineveh.
November	13	God Calls Isaiah	Isaiah 6:1-8 (Luke 5:8-10)
		Twenty-sixth Sunday after Pentecost	Call of Isaiah: Holy, holy, holy is God; the prophet's sin, cleansing, and sending.
November	20	God Promises a New Covenant	Jeremiah 36:1-8, 21-23, 27-28; then 31:31-34 (Luke 22:19-20)
		Christ the King/Reign of Christ Sunday	Jeremiah's scroll calls for repentance, but the king burns it. The prophet promises a new covenant, written on the heart.
November	27	Daniel's Hope in God	Daniel 6:6-27 (Luke 23:1-5)
		First Sunday of Advent	Daniel in the lions' den; deliverance; God's kingdom shall never be destroyed.
December	4	Joel: God's Promised Spirit	Joel 2:12-13, 28-29 (Luke 11:13)
		Second Sunday of Advent	Turn to a merciful God, promise of the Spirit.
December	11	Spirit of the Lord upon Me	Isaiah 61:1-11 (Luke 4:16-21)
		Third Sunday of Advent	The Spirit of the Lord is upon me to bring good news, liberty, and to make an everlasting covenant.
December	18	Jesus' Birth Announced	Luke 1:26-49 (Psalm 113 or 113:9)
		Fourth Sunday of Advent	Announcement of Jesus' birth to Mary; he will receive the throne of David.
December	24	Birth of Jesus	Luke 2:1-14 [15-20] (Ps 96 or 96:3)
		Christmas Eve	Birth of Jesus.

December	25	Shepherds Visit	Luke 2:8-20 (Psalm 123:1-2 or 123:2)
		Christmas Day	Shepherds visit the infant Jesus.
January	1	Simeon and Anna	Luke 2:21-38 (Psalm 131 or 131:3)
		First Sunday after Christmas	Simeon and Anna, Lord now you let your servant depart in peace.
January	8	Jesus' Baptism	Luke 3:1-22 (Psalm 51:6-17 or 51:13)
		Baptism of Our Lord	John baptizes, bear fruit worthy of repentance, share what you have.
January	15	Sermon at Nazareth	Luke 4:14-30 (Psalm 146 or 146:7b-8)
		Second Sunday after Epiphany	Sermon at Nazareth (Isaiah fulfilled, Elijah and widow, Elisha and Naaman).
January	22	Fish for People	Luke 5:1-11 (Psalm 90:14-17 or 90:17b)
		Third Sunday after Epiphany	Great catch of fish, Peter will fish for people.
January	29	Healing on the Sabbath	Luke 6:1-16 (Psalm 92 or 92:4)
		Fourth Sunday after Epiphany	Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath (plucking grain, healing a man) and call of disciples
February	5	Raising the Widow's Son	Luke 7:1-17 (Psalm 119:105-107 or 119:107)
		Fifth Sunday after Epiphany	Healing the centurion's slave by a word and raising the widow's son at Nain
February	12	Are You the One?	Luke 7:18-35 (Psalm 146:5-10)
		Sixth Sunday after Epiphany	Tell John what you see and hear.
February	19	Forgiven at Jesus' Feet	Luke 7:36-50 (Psalm 130:3-6)
		Seventh Sunday after Epiphany	Woman weeps at Jesus' feet and is forgiven.

February	26	Transfiguration	Luke 9:28-45 (Psalm 36:5-10 or 36:9)
		Transfiguration of Our Lord	Transfiguration, healing a boy with a demon, passion prediction.
March	1	Jesus Turns to Jerusalem	Luke 9:51-62 (Psalm 5:7-8 or 5:8)
		Ash Wednesday	Jesus starts for Jerusalem, rejected in Samaria, Don't put your hand to the plow and turn back.
March	5	Good Samaritan	Luke 10:25-42 (Psalm 15 or 15:1)
		First Sunday in Lent	Parable of the Good Samaritan
March	12	Lament over Jerusalem	Luke 13:1-9, 31-35 (Psalm 122 or 122:6)
		Second Sunday in Lent	The tower in Siloam and need for repentance, parable of fig tree that bore no fruit, lament over Jerusalem.
March	19	Lost Sheep, Coin, Son	Luke 15:1-32
		Third Sunday in Lent	(Psalm 119:167-176 or 119:176) Parables of lost sheep, coin, prodigal son.
March	26	Rich Man and Lazarus	Luke 16:19-31 (Psalm 41:1-3 or 41:1)
		Fourth Sunday in Lent	Parable of the rich man and Lazarus.
April	2	Zacchaeus	Luke 18:3119:10 (Psalm 84:1-4, 10-12 or 84:10)
		Fifth Sunday in Lent	Healing a blind man, meeting Zacchaeus. Jesus came to seek and save the lost.
April	9	Triumphal Entry	Luke 19:29-44 (Psalm 118:19-23 or 118:20)
		Palm/Passion Sunday	Triumphal entry; Jesus weeps over the city that does not know peace.
April	13	Last Supper	Luke 22:1-27 (Psalm 34:8-10 or 34:8)
		Maundy Thursday	Preparation for the Last Supper, Words of Institution, Jesus is one who serves.

April	14	Crucifixion Good Friday	Luke 23:32-47 (Psalm 31:5-13 or 31:5a) Crucifixion, Father forgive them; today in Paradise; into your hands I commend my Spirit.
April	16	Resurrection Resurrection of Our Lord	Luke 24:1-12 (Psalm 118:17, 21-24 or 118:22) Empty tomb, women perplexed, bring the message.
April	23	Emmaus Road Second Sunday of Easter	Luke 24:13-35 (Psalm 30 or 30:11) "Our hearts burned along the road, as he opened to us the Scriptures."
April	30	Stephen's Witness Third Sunday of Easter	Acts 6:1—7:2a, 44-60 (Luke 23:33-34a, 46) Controversy in the early church; some set aside for service. Stephen forgives and is martyred.
May	7	Ethiopian Eunuch Baptized Fourth Sunday of Easter	Acts 8:26-39 (Luke 24:44-47) Ethiopian reads the Scriptures, comes to believe and be baptized by Philip.
May	14	Council at Jerusalem Fifth Sunday of Easter	Acts 15:1-18 (Luke 2:29-32) Council at Jerusalem, Faith gives identity to both Jews and Gentiles.
May	21	Living by Faith Sixth Sunday of Easter	Galatians 1:13-17; 2:11-21 (Luke 18:9-14) Paul's former life; conflict with Peter at Antioch; justification by faith.
May	28	One in Christ Seventh Sunday of Easter	Galatians 3:1-9, 23-29 (Luke 1:68-79) Neither Jew or Greek, slave or free, male and female; one in Christ.

June	4	Pentecost	Acts 2:1- 4; Galatians 4:1-7
			Pentecost; God pours the Spirit into our hearts so we can call on God as Father.
			and/or Galatians 5:16-26 Fruit of the Spirit (Luke 11:11-13)
